

- (j) purchase, taken on lease or hire, or otherwise acquire, hold, manage or let, sell, exchange, mortgage or otherwise dispose off moveable or immovable properties of every description and all rights or privileges necessary or convenient, to create trust of any or all properties of the Association and/or do any of the acts for the security, preservation and improvement of the properties
- (k) erect, maintain, improve or alter and keep in repair any building, or buildings for the purpose of the Association.
- (l) borrow or raise money in such manner as the Association may think fit and collect subscriptions and donations for the purpose of the Association.
- (m) invest any amount of the Association, not immediately required for any of its objects, in such manner as may from time to time be determined by the Association.
- (n) assist, subscribe, cooperate, affiliate or be affiliated to, or amalgamate with any other public body whether incorporated, registered or unregistered having altogether or in part objects similar to these of the Association.
- (o) create or assist in creating Branches of the Association for any of the purposes aforementioned.
- (p) do all such other lawful things as may be incidental or conducive to the promotion or carrying out of the foregoing objects or any one of them.

6. The income and property of the Association, from whatever source derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association as set-forth in this Memorandum of the Association and no promotion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise, by way of profit to the persons who at any time are or have been members of the Association, or to any person claiming through any of them. Provided that nothing herein shall prevent the payment, in good faith, or remuneration to any officer or servant of the Association, or to any member of the Association, or other person in return for any service actually rendered to the Association.

7. If upon winding up and dissolution of the Association there remains after satisfaction of all debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or disturbed amongst the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having similar purposes of the Association, such institutions to be determined by the Central Council at or before the time of dissolution, and if so far as effects cannot be given to the aforesaid provision, then to some charitable objects.

8. "No" alteration in the Memorandum, and/or Articles of Associations and byelaws shall be made without prior approval of the relevant Commissioner

9. Every member of the Association undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Association in the event of the same being wound up, during the time that he is a member, for payments of the debts and liabilities of the Association contracted during the period of his membership, and the costs, charges and expenses of winding up the same, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributors amongst themselves such amount as may be required by the Association.
10. To run the Society on non-political, non-commercial and non-religious basis.
11. To secure, receive, accept and manage funds, donations, grants endowments and any other moveable property or properties from lawful sources within the country and to utilize them for the furthering and promoting the aims and objects of the Society.
12. Promoters, office bearers and members shall not be the paid employee of the society.
13. The Society shall confine its activities only to the objects of the Society as set forth in the Memorandum of Society and the income and property of the Society from whatever source derived shall be applied solely towards promoting the objects of the Society and no portion whereof shall be paid by way of dividend profit, bonus to any member, office bearer of the Society, or otherwise. Violation of this condition shall be the personal responsibility of the office bearers or members concerned.
