

There shall be the following officers of the Association namely:

President/ President-elect/ Immediate Past President/ Secretary General/ Treasurer/ Two Joint Secretaries.

Chairman of the Publication Committee/Editors of the Journal and Periodicals and Managing Secretary of the Journal.

The Officers aforesaid, except Immediate Past President shall be elected by the delegates at the General Assembly in such manner and hold offices for such terms, and shall enjoy such powers and privileges, and perform such duties as shall be determined from time to time by the Bye-laws.

The Council shall once in every year publish a summary of the proceedings, report on the activities of the Association and its Branches along with an audited statement of accounts.

- (a) A notice may be served by the Association upon any member, either personally or by sending it through the post in a pre-paid letter, addressed to such member at his last known address, appearing in the Register of Members, or by publication of such notice in the Journal and sending a copy of the Journal containing such notice to such member on his last known address.
- (b) A notice required to be served by the Association upon any Provincial Branch will be served on the General secretary or the President of such Provincial Branch.
- (c) Any notice or copy of the Journal containing the same, if posted shall be deemed to have been served in due course and in proving such service, it shall be sufficient to prove that the letter or the copy of the Journal containing the notice properly addressed and put into the Post Office.

The proceedings of the General Assembly or of the Central Council, or any Committee or Sub-committee or other Body duly constituted or any of its Branches shall not be invalidated by any accidental omission to give any notice thereby required or by absence of a member, by any defect in the election or qualifications of any of their members.

Where by the Regulations or the Bye-laws any act or thing is required to be done by the Association, the same may be done by such officer or member of the Association as the Central Council may appoint for the purpose.
