The Central Council

Terms of Office:

- (a) The Central Council is a continuing body.
- (b) The Biennial Meeting of the Central Council shall finish its transaction before the inauguration of Pakistan Medical Conference.
- (c) The President-elect shall assume the office of the President for the First Day of the Pakistan Medical Conference.
- (d) Only those representatives of the Branches whose names are on the list of the Councilors maintained at the Central Office at least six weeks before the date of the ensuing Meeting of the Central Council shall be entitled to attend it and only those who attended the Biennial Meeting of the Central Council held during the Session of the Pakistan Medical Conference.
- (e) Special Representative may be elected or selected, whenever deemed necessary by the Central Council.
- (f) Except in the case of President and President-elect, all other casual vacancies of the office-bearers will be filled in by the Central Council.

Meetings of the Central Council

Ordinarily, the Central Council will meet at least once in every four months. The meeting of the Central Council shall be held in turn in each of the provinces of Pakistan or at a convenient place, date and time to be decided by the Secretary General in consultation with the President.

A Special Requisition Meeting of the Council shall be called within four weeks, on receipt of requisition signed by at least ten members of the Council stating the business for which the Special Meeting shall be fixed by the Secretary General in consultation with the President.

Notices for the Central Council Meetings

- (a) At least two week's Notice of the meeting shall be given to all members, stating the place, the date and the hours of the meeting and the agenda of business to be transacted there at.
- (b) In emergencies a shorter notice shall be allowed at the discretion of the Secretary General in consultation with the President, but in no case it shall be less than four days.

Quorum of the Central Council Meetings

The quorum for meetings of the Central Council shall be not less than Four or one-third of the total number of the Central Council.
