

20. Business at the Biennial Central Council Meeting

A meeting of the Central Council will immediately precede the Biennial General Meeting at the same place where the "Biennial General Meeting" is to be held. This will be called Biennial Central Council Meeting" and will transact the following business along with others:

- (a) Recitation of Holy Quran.
- (b) Minutes of the last meeting.
- (c) Adoption of the following reports of the activities of the Association for previous two years.
 - (i) Secretary General's Report.
 - (ii) Report of the Managing Secretary, Journal of the Pakistan Medical Association.
 - (iii) Report of the Editors of Publications of the Pakistan Medical Association.
- (d) Adoption of the audited accounts to be placed by the Treasurer.
- (e) Consideration of the proposed amendments to the Constitution and Bye-laws, if any.
- (f) Consideration of resolutions to be placed in the General Meeting.
- (g) Deciding the venue of the next General Body Meeting.
- (h) Any other matter with the permission of the Chairman.

21/22. General Rules about the Biennial Meeting of the Central Council

- (a) Except with the special permission of the Chairman, no resolution shall be placed before the Biennial Meeting of the Central Council that has not been previously given notice of and duly circulated with the Agenda of the meetings.
- (b) Resolutions sponsored by the individual Members and the Local Branches, shall reach the Secretary General through the local branches and/or provincial branches. Individual Members and Local Branches, however, shall have the rights to send any resolution direct to the Secretary General of the Association, provided a copy has also previously been submitted to the Local Branch and/or Provincial Branch.
- (c) Notice of resolutions to be moved at the Biennial Meeting of the Central Council shall reach the Secretary General of the Association at least a month before the meeting.
