

26. The Journal and other Periodicals Published by the Association.

(a) There shall be a Journal OF the Association.

(i) The Journal of the Association shall be under the charge of the Editor who shall receive assistance and guidance from the Editorial Board.

(b) Other Periodicals.

The other Periodicals of the Association shall be under the charge of their respective Editors.

(c) The functions of the Editors:

- (a) The Editors will have over-all responsibility of the publications of Pakistan Medical Association Journals and Periodicals.
- (b) It will be their responsibility to see that nothing be published against the aims, objects and interest of the Association.
- (c) The staff will be responsible to them.
- (d) They shall be responsible along with the Managing Secretaries for the management of the business of the Journal and Periodicals, their printing, securing of advertisements, distribution of Journal and Periodicals among the Members, etc.
- (e) They shall prepare budget estimates and submit it through the Secretary General for consideration and sanction at the first meeting of the Central Council every year.
- (f) They shall prepare a quarterly statement of accounts of the Journals and periodicals to be placed before the Central Council through the Secretary General.
- (g) They shall prepare a yearly statement of accounts and get it audited by the Auditors appointed by the Association and submit it through the Secretary General before the last meeting of the Central Council every year.
- (h) They shall have powers to spend money for various purposes connected with the Journal and Periodicals up to the amount sanctioned in the budget estimates for the year by the Central Council.

(d) Editorial Board.

There will be an Editorial Board for the Journal of the Association.

2. The Editor
3. Joint Editor
4. Two Assistant Editors.
5. The Managing Secretary of the Journal
6. The Secretary General, President (or his nominee who shall be a Member of the Central Council).
