

54. **General Rules**

- (a) The Secretary General of the Association shall make available to the members of the Association present at the Conference, copies of all the resolutions.
- (b) The Reception Committee in consultation with the Secretary General of the Association shall make arrangements for the meetings of the General Assembly and the Central Council which shall be held at the place of the Conference.

55. **Standing Committees**

The first meeting of the Central Council held after Biennial Pakistan Medical Conference shall constitute the following Standing Committees which shall be responsible to it.

(a) Ahmed Forces Standing Committee

- (i) In accordance with Article 7(iv) and 8(j) the members of the Armed Forces Medical Services are eligible to be attached members of P.M.A.
- (ii) The Central Council shall constitute a Standing Committee to consider matters relating to the Medical Branches of the Armed Forces and report it to the Central Council for advice and action.

(iii) Composition

The President of the P.M.A., Secretary General and two members elected from amongst its members by the Central Council together with the four co-opted members comprising of the Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services and one member each from the three services, one of them being preferably of a specialized status and the other two of the rank of Major, Lieutenant Commander, Squadron Leader or below, as the case may be shall comprise the Standing Committee.

- (iv) The representative of Armed Forces Medical Services on the Standing Committee shall elect one of them to be an attached member of the Central Council with no voting right'

(b) Central Ethical Standing Committee

The Central Council shall constitute a Central Ethical Standing Committee to discuss, advise on the Ethics of Medical Profession and suggest ways and means to implement the Rules of Ethics, report to the Central Council any lapses of Ethics within the profession and suggest any measures against the guilty persons.

Composition

- (ii) The Committee shall be constituted of five members elected by the Central Council from amongst its members.
